

Fragen zur Vorbereitung auf die mündliche Englischprüfung Teil 1 (Interview)

About yourself

What is your name? Can you spell your surname?

How old are you? When were you born? Where were you born?

Can you describe yourself? (appearance and character: Make sure that you can tell your teacher at least 3 personal qualities)

About your family

Where do you live? Who lives with you? What can you tell about those people? (eg: I live with my mother, my father and my little brother. My mother works as a nurse and my father is an engineer. My little brother is ten years old and he is in class 4.)

What can you tell your teachers about your relationship with your parents?

Have you got pets at home? Which?

About your hometown

What is your hometown? What do you like/ dislike about your hometown? What is special about your hometown? (eg: Falkensee is a town with more than 40 thousand people. It is right on the border to the German capital Berlin.)

What can people/ young people/ tourists do in your hometown? Are there special places that are worth visiting? Which restaurants do you like there?

About your school

What is the name of your school? Where is it? What kind of school is it? (secondary school)

What can you tell your teachers about the school building? What can you say about the subjects?

Which subjects do you love/ like/ hate? Which subjects are you good at/ not really good at? Can you say something about the teachers? What do you like/ don't like about your school? What would you change if you had the chance to?

About your future plans

What will you do after the tenth class? (go to grammar school and take the A-level (Abitur); start an apprenticeship; take part in social projects...)

What job do you want to do?

Where do you want to live? (in the country or city or a smaller town like Falkensee? Why)

Which dreams do you have about starting a family?

Can you imagine living and working in another country?

About your dream job

What is your dream job? Tell us about it. (where, what you do, what it is like, who or what you work with, pay, personal qualities, working hours etc – look at previous part: job)

About an ideal friend or partner

Have you got a best friend? What should a best friend be like? What do you do together with your friend? Do you think it's better to have many good friends or one best friend? Why? How do you imagine your future partner being like?

About your free time

What do you do in your free time? Which sports do you do? Would you like to do something else?
Where do you spend your free time? Do you like watching films? What kinds of films do you like?
What do you think makes a good film? Do you prefer watching films at home or at the cinema? Why?
What do you think about playing computer games? Have you got a computer at home? What do you use it for?
What are the dangers of the internet? How much do you use your mobile phone? What do you use it for?
What are the dangers of using the mobile phone too much?

About travelling

Where do you usually spend your holidays? What did you plan for the summer holidays?
Is there a place that you would like to visit once in your life? What would you like to do there?
Where would you never go and why not? Which places have you visited in Germany so far?
What do you prefer – winter holidays or summer holidays? Why?

About global warming and technology

In which way do you experience global warming?
What kind of technology do you use in your everyday life? Can you imagine giving up something?
What and why? What do you and your family do to stop global warming/ to reduce your footprint?
